



SchoolJam USA 2011-2012

SchoolJam USA is a one-of-a-kind battle of the bands competition, where students can compete for gear for their bands—and their school music programs!

Who can enter?

From August 1 to October 21, 2011, anyone in a band whose members are between the ages of 13 and 19 and who aren't—and have never been—signed to a music label can enter at www.schooljamusa.com. See official rules for more specific details.

What kind of music?

Any style of music, as long as it's original music (no cover bands) or the music falls under public domain. Lyrics must be acceptable.

How does it work?

Teens across the country can register their bands online. All qualifying bands will battle it out online for 8 finalist spots. Finalists are chosen through a combination of public vote and music scores determined by a panel of qualified judges.

Who can vote?

From November 1 through November 30, 2011, anyone over the age of 13 can register to vote once a day at www.schooljamusa.com.

Where are the finals?

The top 8 bands will be invited to participate in the live finals next January to be held in Anaheim, California, during the world-famous NAMM Show.

What are the prizes?

Each of the 8 finalists will receive prize money to purchase new gear—as will their school music programs! In addition, the winning band will travel to Europe in March to perform at the 2012 SchoolJam Germany finals in Frankfurt.
