

BT-105 Hands Free Wireless Page Turner for Tablets and Computers by AirTurn, Inc.

Musicians are discovering the convenience of being able to carry their entire sheet music collections in computers and tablets like the iPad and forgoing the bulk of gig books and heavy binders. But for musicians using both hands to play their instrument, the need to swipe the screen to turn pages can be an annoying distraction. With the AirTurn BT-105, tablet computers like the iPad finally become practical sheet music reading tools for musicians who need to keep their hands on their instruments and their focus on the music.

The AirTurn BT-105 is a Bluetooth wireless page turning transmitter that connects to two foot pedals for forwards and backwards page turns. The AirTurn BT-105 is compatible with a growing number of apps for iPad and Android tablets, ranging from PDF and eBook readers to teleprompters and hands free sound patch controllers. It can also be configured to work with Bluetooth-equipped Mac and PC computers that can accept Page Down and Page Up keyboard commands, such as Adobe Acrobat, Microsoft Word, Power Point, Keynote, and most other document and presentation programs.

The AirTurn BT-105 comes bundled with two ATFS-2 silent pedals and a pedal board. The ATFS-2 is designed to be the quietest foot pedal on the consumer market today. The ATFS-2 features a proprietary "mechanism free" design, where there are no moving parts aside from the molded hinge. Manufactured in Colorado, the ATFS-2 is injection molded with a unique blend of high strength plastics, making it virtually indestructible.
